She graduated from the Carlos López Buchardo National Conservatory of Music (Argentina), where she was a student of Maestro Hugo Pierre, being the first graduate of that career, succeeding him after his retirement in the chair of this institution. He perfected himself in the classical repertoire with Maestro André Hemmers in Holland. He has won prizes at the Youth Art Biennial, at the Argentine Music Competition and at the First International Music Competition in Buenos Aires.

Discography: Two albums dedicated entirely to Chamber works for saxophone with the pianist Martha Fornella (his mother), presented on tours of Canada and the United States, stand out. He participated in the recording of the series of compact discs of the collection "Panorama de la Música Argentina" and in the series of discs by the Argentine composer Irma Urteaga. With the saxophone quartet "4MIL" he records a CD dedicated to atypical works by Piazzolla, Salgán and Rovira, and in 2019 the great Duo "Zwei Akte" by Mauricio Kagel, together with the harpist Lucrecia Janca.

He has premiered a large number of works for different chamber ensembles. As a soloist, he has performed in front of the Philharmonic Orchestras of the Teatro Colón, the National Symphony, the Mayo Chamber Orchestra, the La Plata Chamber Orchestra, the Tucumán Symphony, the Filiberto Orchestra, the S.O.D.R.E Orchestra of Uruguay, and the National Symphony Orchestra of Costa Rica. Among others, Invited by the Teatro Colón Chamber Orchestra, she has toured Brazil and France.

She has been summoned as a jury at International Saxophone Festivals in Costa Rica, Brazil and Argentina. From 1994 she held the position of alto saxophone in the Symphonic Band of the City of Buenos Aires and since 2006 she has been a saxophone teacher at the "Manuel de Falla" Conservatory of Music. She is a member of the saxophone quartet "4MIL", the traveling quartet "CLAM", the Latin American quartet of women saxophonists and the reed quintet "TORRE 7 Ensemble". The prestigious Konex Foundation awarded him the Diploma of Merit in the field of classical music in Argentina.
